Key Responsibilities:

- Identify psychosocial needs of Southern District Health Centre clients, provide counselling services and organize community health programmes
- Plan and implement patient empowerment programs and community programs in centre and outreaching service spots
- Develop program guidelines and workflow of social work services
- Work with multi-disciplinary professional teams to deliver primary health care services
- Liaise with different stakeholders including government officials, network medical practitioners, professional groups, district stakeholders and related parties on community resources mobilization and service collaboration

- Experience as Registered Social Worker in social and medical services, with experience in community healthcare service or/and patient self-management services in public services/ NGOs preferred
